



Request for transport of a corpse abroad, *including to Greenland*

It is hereby certified that the corpse of (name of the deceased and CPR no. or similar)

and that the corpse is placed in a coffin that complies with the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of Danish Ministry of the Interior Order no. 152 of 14 April 1983 on the Handling of Corpses, as

- the coffin consists of an outer wooden coffin whose sides are at least 20 mm thick, and an interior coffin of carefully soldered zinc¹.
Soldering Certificate **must be attached**.
For transport by air, an *Embalming Certificate* **must be attached** or certificate of approved pressure equalisation mechanism with filter **must be attached** ².
- the coffin is a simple wooden coffin whose sides are at least 30 mm thick and lined with a layer of zinc, section 3(2), paragraph b.
For transport by air, a certificate of approved pressure equalisation mechanism with filter **must be attached**².
- the coffin, which is to be transported to Finland, Iceland, Norway or Sweden, consists of an airtight and sufficiently solid material³.
However, the entity performing the transport may impose stricter requirements on the nature of the coffin.

It is further certified that the coffin only contains the corpse or corpse remains of the above-mentioned person and personal belongings which are permitted under Danish law to be buried or cremated with the corpse.
